## The Museum Gallery

Founded by Marian Parmenter and Sally Lilienthal in 1978, the Museum Gallery of San Francisco provides a forum for artists and collectors to exchange ideas about contemporary art. Painting, sculpture, photography, video, experimental media and limited edition prints are represented in the exhibitions and collections. As a supportive arm of the San Francisco Museum of Modern Art, the Museum Gallery educates and serves a broad spectrum of corporate and individual patrons. At the Gallery, both untutored and seasoned collectors alike are engaged in the process of discovering and refining their attitudes toward original art. Through sales and rental programs, collectors are offered the opportunity to enter into a dialogue with art of their choice by renting before making a commitment to purchase. Through their continuing relationship to the Gallery, many patrons are involved in the process of forming important collections of art by selected California artists.

As well as the sale and rental of art, the Museum Gallery offers diverse exhibitions with a unique perspective throughout the year. Through these exhibits the Gallery offers a direct encounter with a broad range of innovative original art, often seen for the first time. Figurative images may find expression in a joint sculpture and painting exhibition; an environmental artist may work directly with the architecture of the gallery space. An exhibit at the Museum Gallery has been, for many artists, the strong beginning of a professional career. The Gallery also supports mid-career and mature artists in all forms of contemporary art.

Representing 500 artists and as many clients, the Gallery has brought a breadth of artistic expression to the greater Bay Area over the past decade. The vision of its collectors and their willingness to support new and significant art has provided continuing encouragement to the Gallery in its endeavors.
